A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ARROYO GRANDE AUTHORIZING THE CONTINUED TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF SHORT STREET SOUTH OF EAST BRANCH STREET AND NORTH OF OLOHAN ALLEY TO ACCOMMODATE ITS USE AS A PEDESTRIAN AND PUBLIC AREA

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to California Vehicle Code Section 21101(e), on June 23, 2020 the City Council temporarily closed Short Street south of east Branch Street and north of Olohan Alley via Resolution 5006 to accommodate its use as an outdoor eating area during the COVID-19 pandemic; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council is evaluating the permanent closure and redevelopment of Short Street south of east Branch Street and north of Olohan for possible future use as a pedestrian plaza and park; and

**WHEREAS**, during the time that plans for the possible permanent closure and redevelopment of Short Street are being prepared and evaluated, the Council desires to keep Short Street south of east Branch Street and north of Olohan Alley closed to vehicles and allow its use as a pedestrian and public area.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the City Council of the City of Arroyo Grande hereby:

- 1. Authorizes the continued temporary closure of Short Street south of East Branch Street and north of Olohan Alley until such time as the future use of Short Street has been determined.
- 2. The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this Resolution and shall cause a certified copy to be filed in the Office of the City Clerk.
