Hello Jessica,


Would you be so kind and make sure my comments are read during tomorrow's session?

-Add more color to the design to avoid a monochromatic appearance.(It has an unusual green color covering the entire mural-the butterflies aren't even their beautiful orange color. And the monarchs are great but feel it's not really Arroyo Grande but more so Grover beach.)



-Modify the design to tell a story about Arroyo Grande (I feel it would be best to come up with a design that reflects the town better.)


Hello Sarah,

Also, the current items don't seem unique to ag as he has done similar designs in other towns as well-seen below on his Instagram:








