RECOMMENDATION

Appoint one AGTBID Board member and one alternate to serve as a representative on the Arroyo Grande Community Service Grant Committee.

BACKGROUND

The 2021-22 Arroyo Grande Community Service Grant Program is intended to provide monetary grants to eligible community nonprofit organizations. The City recognizes the value of such groups, which provide specialized social service, educational, cultural, beautification, and recreation programs and projects that benefiting Arroyo Grande citizens. Grants will be awarded in minimum amounts of not less than \$250. The funding for 2021-22 Community Service Grant Program is \$82,065. Completed applications forms, along with supplemental documents, were submitted by 5 pm on Friday, December 17, 2021. A grant committee will review the applications.
