*This certification is pending approval and authorization of the City Council of Arroyo Grande, which approved a Cost Sharing Memorandum of Agreement Framework on August 11, 2020 and adopted findings as a responsible agency under the California Environmental Quality Act in support of the Central Coast Blue Project on March 23, 2021, but has not yet approved participation in the Project. The City of Arroyo Grande will not construct the Project; however, it is anticipated that Arroyo Grande will fund 25% of the Project costs incurred by the City of Pismo Beach, which will construct the Project, in exchange for 25% of the water produced by the Project. It is anticipated that the Arroyo Grande City Council will consider approval of a Cost Sharing Agreement with the Cities of Pismo Beach and Grover Beach and approval of participation in the Project in January or February 2022. The Cost Sharing Agreement requires formation of a Joint Powers Authority, with the Cities of Arroyo Grande, Grover Beach, and Pismo Beach as its members, that will own and operate the facility following completion of construction by Pismo Beach. Resolutions authorizing the submittal of this application will also be presented for consideration by the Arroyo Grande City Council. If approval and authorization are not provided by the City Council, this application will be withdrawn by the undersigned.
